PURPOSE:

Physician staff is available to care for the severely injured patient.

POLICY STATEMENT:

The Trauma Center will offer access to appropriate specialty physicians 24 hours a day 7 days a week to meet the patient care needs of the community.

ENTITIES AFFECTED BY THIS POLICY (SCOPE):

WakeMed adopts the following policy & procedures for WakeMed Raleigh and WakeMed Cary. Including where available by campus: General Surgery & Trauma Services, Neurosurgery, Orthopedic Surgery, ENT, Ophthalmology, Pediatric Surgery, Spine Surgery.

WHO SHOULD READ THIS POLICY:

This policy shall be read by department supervisors, managers, directors, and administrators. Furthermore, any individual considering issuing, revising, assisting in the drafting of, or archiving a policy.

PROCEDURES:

- I. General Surgery and Trauma Service schedules are supervised by the Medical Director of Trauma/Surgery and are generated by the General Surgery and Trauma service. At the Raleigh Campus, a back-up surgeon for call is always available.
- II. Call schedules, where available by campus, for specialty services include, but are not limited to: Neurosurgery, Orthopedic Surgery, ENT, Ophthalmology, Pediatric surgery and spine.
 - a. For Neurosurgical emergency refer to Neurosurgical emergency contingency plan policy.
