

The President's Report – Raleigh Campus



Greetings Raleigh Volunteers!

Spring is over and summer is now upon us - how quickly time flies! You are to be commended for your commitment to volunteering even during the vacation season! I trust you are, or will be, enjoying some vacation time to relax, enjoying family and friends. Now that summer is here, we love seeing the many Juniors that have joined the ranks - you are greatly appreciated! Also those of you who are not visible, because you work behind the scenes at home - knitting, sewing, quilting and crocheting for both adults and children, bringing them comfort. We are grateful for each volunteer, no matter what you do or how many hours you spend giving to WakeMed - you

are important to us!

I was privileged to attend, and proudly represent, WakeMed at a very special gathering in April. This was the annual meeting for the Wake County Project Linus chapter, where many individuals who have worked behind the scenes all year long come together. Project Linus is a national organization, started in 1995 and named after the beloved Peanuts© comic strip blanket toting character. Its mission is to provide love, a sense of security, warmth and comfort to children who are seriously ill, traumatized, or otherwise in need, with handmade blankets. Another part of the mission is to provide a rewarding and fun service opportunity for interested individuals and groups in local communities, for the benefit of children. Nearly 400 chapters exist nationally, with more than







4,000,000 blankets donated. The Wake County chapter was started in 1996, and since then, over 37,800 blankets have been donated to children in need. The blankets are quilted, made with fleece, crocheted or knitted.

It was amazing to witness 75 - 100 volunteers gathered together working on blankets that would be donated throughout Wake County. The largest percentage goes to the various WakeMed facilities! I loved the fact that there were not only women, but also boys and girls, as well as men, sitting on the floor or at tables with their families and friends, tying knots in fleece blankets and helping in other ways. There were several people, including a young girl who gave touching testimonies as to how Project Linus helped to give them or a loved one comfort during difficult hospital stays. Welcome to Summer!




