	Medications Requiring Central Line	

Medications that Require a Central Line

Central line REQUIRED for the following medications (only exception is life-threatening or emergent situations deemed by the provider):

- 1. 23.4% saline
- 2. Mannitol
- 3. Potassium chloride 20mEq/50mL (only this concentration)
- 4. Vancomycin 10mg/mL concentration (this is not our standard concentration)
- 5. Dextrose > 10%
- 6. Parenteral Nutrition

Central line RECOMMENDED/PREFERRED over peripheral administration (central line not required but should be used if one is present; consider central line placement if duration of therapy will be extended and/or high doses are required, unless provider chooses to continue peripheral administration based on the clinical situation):

- 1. Calcium chloride
- 2. Dobutamine
- 3. Dopamine
- 4. Epinephrine
- 5. Norepinephrine
- 6. Phenylephrine
- 7. Vasopressin
- 8. 3% saline
