

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PURPOSE:

Provide guidelines for managing non-compressible torso hemorrhage secondary to blunt chest trauma and penetrating abdominal trauma. REBOA (resuscitative endovascular balloon occlusion of the aorta) is provided as an appropriate alternative to resuscitative thoracotomy for management of hemorrhagic shock and significant intra-abdominal hemorrhage from solid organ injury and/or pelvic fracture with ring disruption.


CONTRAINDICATIONS: * Minors (younger than 18 years old) * Pregnant *Major vascular injuries above the diaphragm
