- Specially-trained nurse preceptors who provide mentoring and guidance

Program overview

- Phase One: Six-month structured program combining educational content, personalized clinical orientation and emotional support, allowing you to integrate theory with the skills required to deliver outstanding and compassionate patient care.
- Phase Two: Six months of support sessions to maximize individual growth, providing you with the one-on-one personal guidance that will allow for a smooth transition into the work environment.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the WakeMed Nurse Fellowship Program, you must:

- Be a new graduate with RN license or eligible to take the NCLEX.
- Provide two letters of reference from a clinical instructor during the interview process.
- If offered a Fellows position, a RN license will be required prior to start date.
