**S**tarted in 2000, Project Access is a physician volunteer program in Wake County that provides specialized health care services, prescription medicine assistance and health education to low income, uninsured Wake County residents. Project Access is a program of the Wake County Medical Society, started with funding from the Hospital Alliance for Community Health and the Wake County Commissioners; supported since 2007 by WakeMed, Rex Healthcare, Duke Raleigh Hospital, the John Rex Endowment, Duke Endowment and Blue Cross and Blue Shield of North Carolina Foundation.

#### Volunteer Needs

Community physicians and practices who will accept a designated number of referrals for examination and treatment. Project Access staff determines patient eligibility, makes only appropriate referrals, provides patient reminders and tracks contributions made by community physicians.

**C**ommunity Care of Wake & Johnston Counties is a network of community physicians that provide Medicaid services in a linked network of community resources including nurse care management, chronic disease management, health education, pharmacy consultations, mental health and social service. The program is funded by the State of North Carolina and physicians are reimbursed for their clinical services as well as a management fee for each of their patients in the network. Joining Community Care does not increase your requirement to accept more Medicaid patients.

**A**lliance Medical Ministry is a non-profit clinic that opened in 2003 with a mission to provide affordable, primary medical care to low income, uninsured working families in Wake County.

Alliance operates like any other private doctor's office with board-certified physicians providing primary care to patients who pay a small fee. The comprehensive care provided includes acute and chronic medical care, urgent care appointments, preventative medicine and health education, monthly screening eye exams for diabetic patients, all necessary lab work, free or reduced priced medications, monthly ENT and GYN clinics, and 24-hour coordination of care including a bilingual after-hours answering service.

#### Volunteer Needs

Alliance works with volunteer physicians to staff clinics, and also relies on community physicians to accept referrals for specialty care.
