

Granny Style Crochet Baby Hat Pattern



Materials:

Light weight yarn - #3 weighted, sport, or DK

Size 7 crochet hook (4.5 mm)

Yarn needle

Stitches used:

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

dc inc = double crochet increase

hdc = half double crochet

sl st = slip stitch

sts = stitches

Double crochet increase (dc inc) = make two double crochets into the same stitch

Pattern:

Make a magic circle, or ch 3 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 2, 12 dc into the ring, slip stich into the top stitch of the ch 2 to join (12 dc)

Round 2: Ch 2, dc inc in each stitch around, join with a slip stich. (24 dc)

Round 3: Ch2, make *1 dc in next 3 sts, then dc inc in next stitch, repeat from * all around, join with a slip stitch. (30 dc)

Round 4: Ch 2, * dc inc in next stitch, 1 dc in next 14 sts, repeat from * Join with a slip stitch (32 dc)

Round 5: Ch 2 and make 1 dc in same stitch as the chain, * skip 1 stitch, make 2 dc in next stitch, continue from * around and join with a slip stitch. (17 pairs)

Round 6: Sl st across to first space between pairs, ch 3 and make 1 dc in the space (first pair). Then make 2 dc in each remaining space to end of row and join with a sl st. (17 pairs)

Round 7 – 11: Repeat Round 6 or rows needed for size.

Round 12: (Trim now). Ch 2, 1 hdc in each stitch around join with a slip stitch. Fasten off. Weave in ends with yarn needle.

When laid flat this hat need to be 5 – 7” diameter and 5 – 7” height, the size and yarn-weight requirements for donations to Wakemed-Cary Hospital.

Add pompoms.
