

# New Insurance for 2023?

## Update your insurance in MyChart


With the start of a new year and many insurance changes happening, it's now easier than ever to update your insurance information through the **MyChart App**.

After logging in on the MyChart App, click the *"Menu"* button (the three stacked lines) and choose *"Insurance Summary"* (under the Insurance section).


You can add any new insurance policies during this step by clicking *"Add a Coverage"* and then uploading a copy of your insurance card by clicking *"Add Insurance Card Photo"*. Don't forget to include photos of both the front and the back of the insurance card.

If the insurance card is available electronically, save a copy of the card or take a screenshot of the card on your phone and upload it directly via the MyChart app. This can also be completed by signing in to MyChart on a computer.

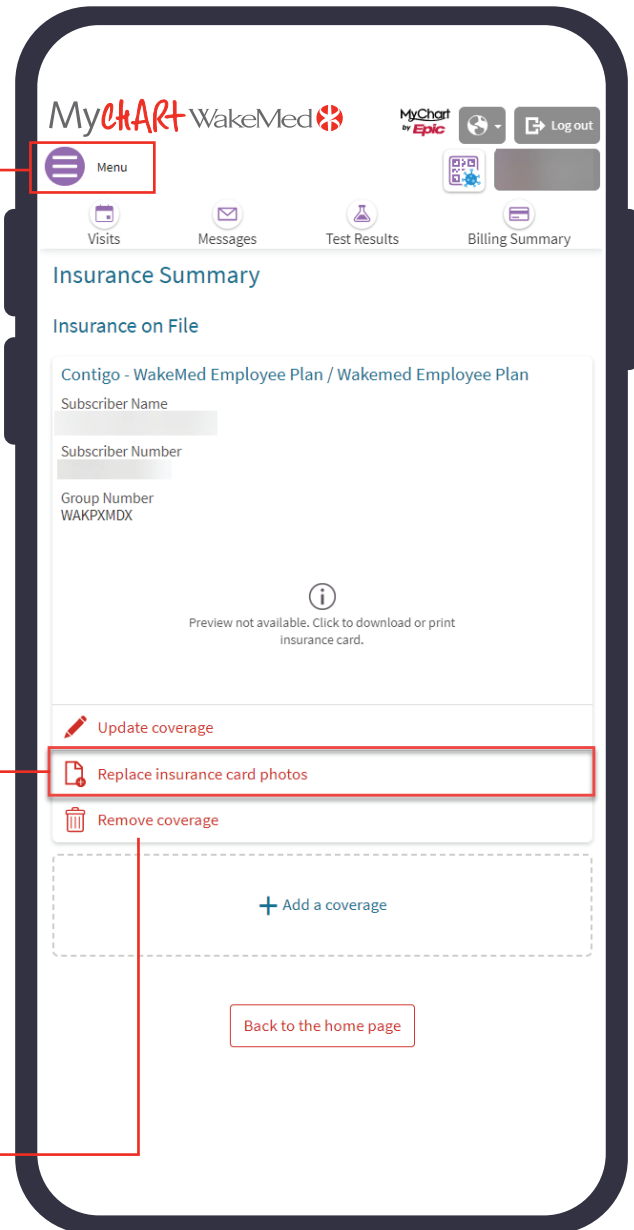
 **Add back**
