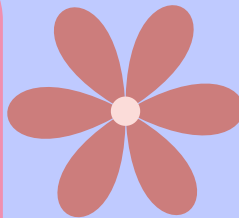
## Most Requested

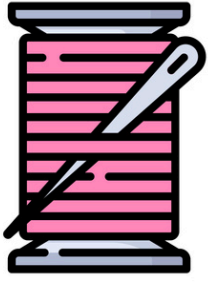


- **Adult Sized Blankets**

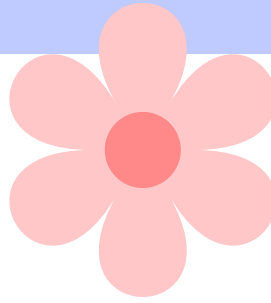
